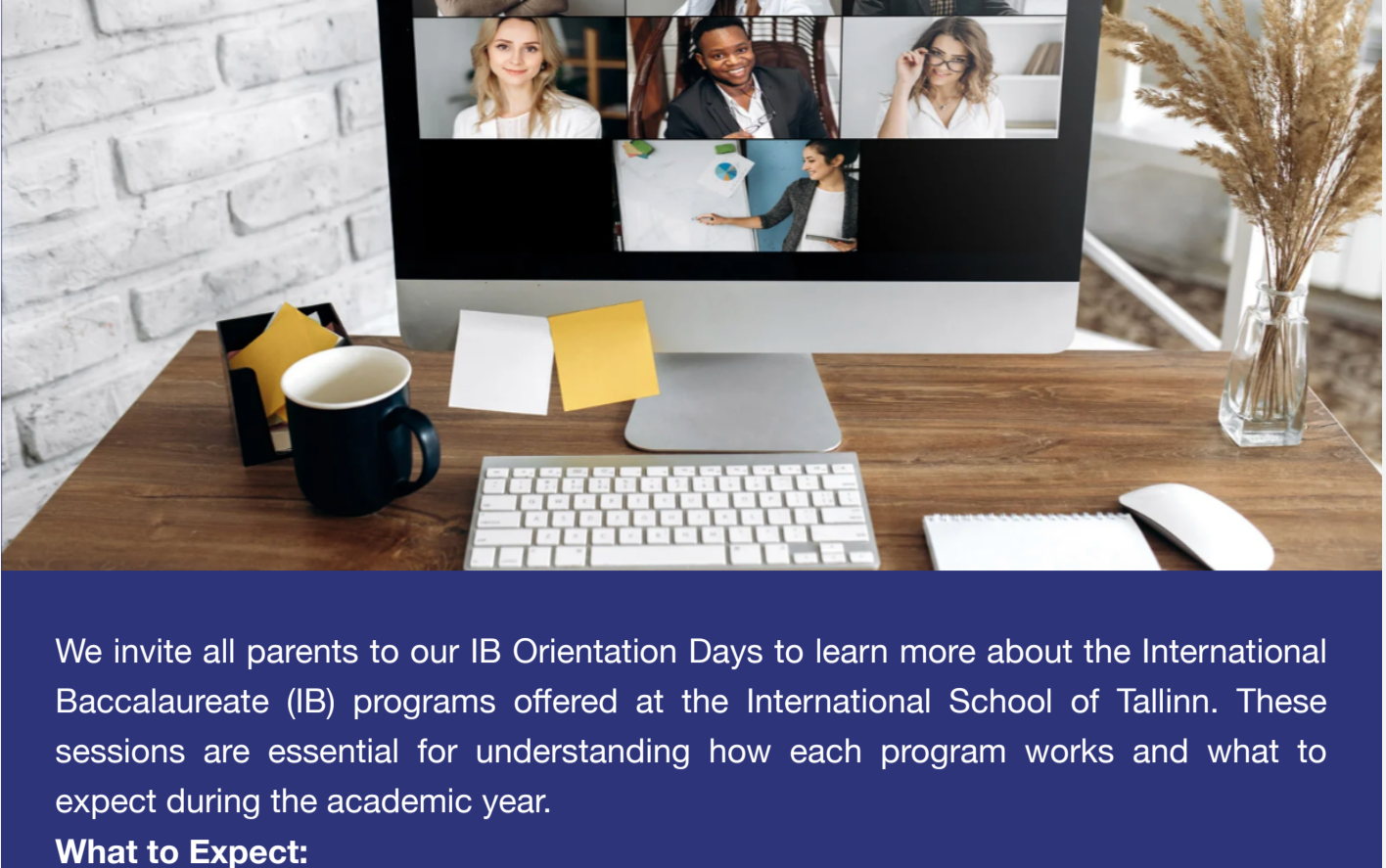


IB Orientation Day: October 9 & 16

A Zoom link will be provided by the IB coordinators prior to the event. We encourage everyone to participate and ask questions!

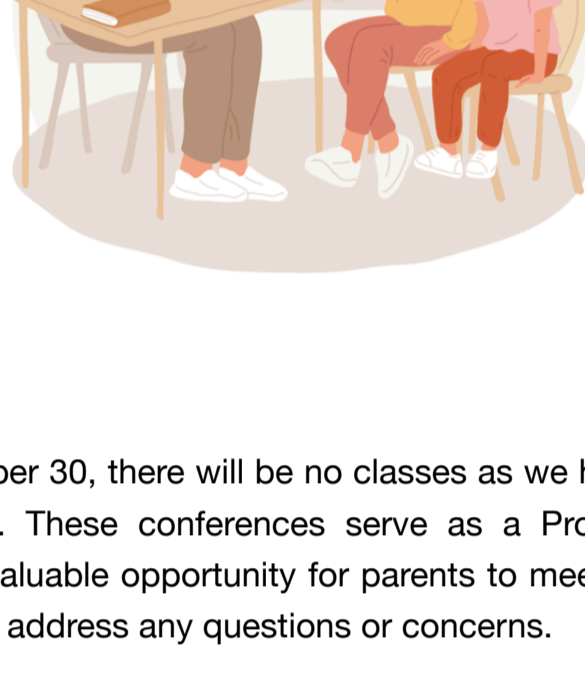
October 4 - Teachers Day: Special Student-Led Lessons

Important Details:

- Parents will schedule one-on-one meetings with teachers. You will have the opportunity to meet with both homeroom and subject teachers, depending on your child's courses.
- All students should attend the meetings to foster an open dialogue about their academic progress and goals.
- Childcare will be provided for those who need it. A sign up form will also be sent.
- Sign-up forms for scheduling meetings will be sent to parents by the IB coordinators prior to the event. Each parent will need to sign up for time slots separately for each teacher they wish to meet.
- Students will not have classes on this day, but they will be expected to participate in their conferences.

Exciting News: Top Rating in Nationwide Student Satisfaction Survey!

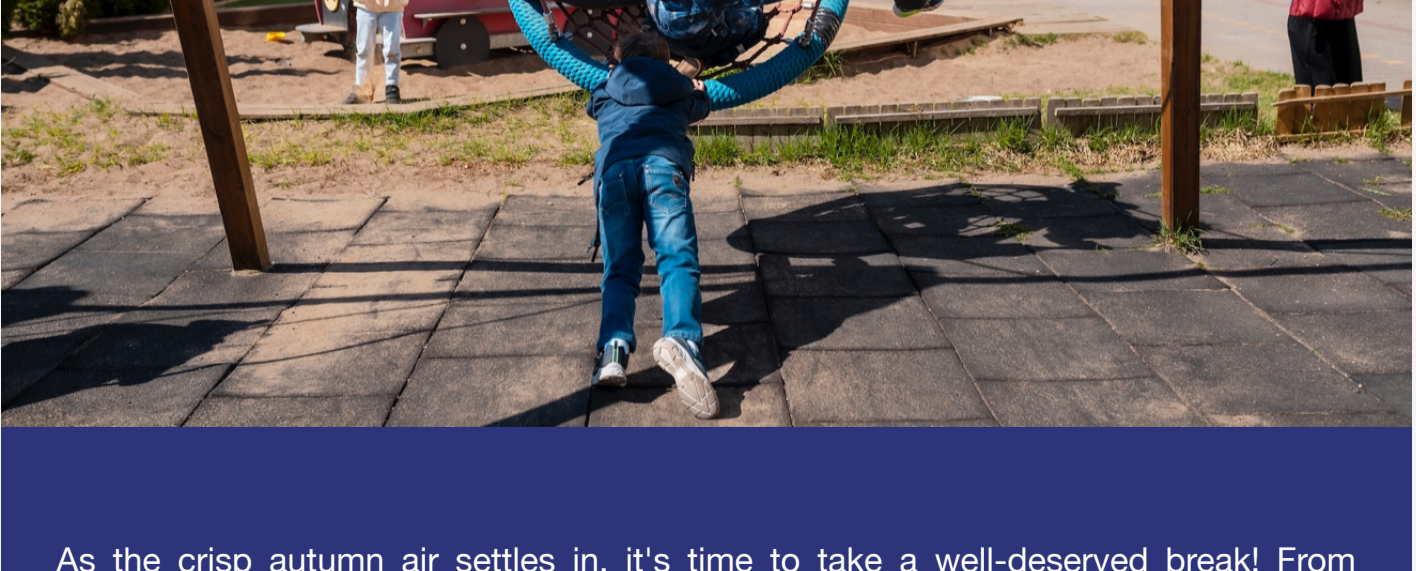
